Early Stage 1: Kindergarten

- Daily Reading: Students are encouraged to engage in daily reading for at least 10-15 minutes. This can include reading aloud with a parent or caregiver, independent reading, or listening to stories.
- Graphemes and Phonemes

Stage 1: Year 1 & 2

- **Daily Reading**: Students should continue with daily reading for 15-20 minutes.
- Graphemes and Phonemes
- Multiplication Tables: Practice multiplication tables of twos, threes, fives, and tens using
 rhythmic counting and skip counting.

Stage 2: Year 3 & 4

- Daily Reading: Maintain daily reading for 20-25 minutes.
- **Multiplication Tables**: Focus on multiplication tables of twos, threes, fours, fives, sixes, eights, and tens.
- Oral Language & Communication: School and Multicultural Public Speaking

Stage 3: Year 5 & 6

- **Daily Reading**: Continue daily reading for 25-30 minutes.
- Multiplication Tables: Work on multiplication tables of sevens, nines, elevens, and twelves.
- Oral Language & Communication: School and Multicultural Public Speaking
- STEM Expo
